	Do not locate closer than 1m to any slab edge, penetration or other step-down, unless a fixed fence, rail or suitably high secure barrier is in place.
	Do not exceed scaffolds working load (as per the manufacturers guidelines). Keep scaffold loads to a minimum (including tools and other equipment) and remove all equipment when the scaffold is not in use.
	A hard hat should be worn at all times by all persons working in the vicinity of the fall area.
