KEY OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use one fan per room (up to 36 sq m)
- 2. Carefully lift the carpet from the tackles strip and fold back approx.. 1m.
- 3. Do not stand the unit in water
- 4. Plug in to a standard outlet with the correct voltage and amperage for the unit
- 5. Place the fan in the corner with snout facing the centre of the room
- 6. Do not block air intake vents
- 7. Set the switch at the desired speed: low, medium or high (carpet should lift/float with a cushion of air below)
- 8. Check for proper operation before leaving the unit unattended
- 9. Run the fan until carpet, underlay and floor are completely dry. This could take up to 4 days.
- 10. Do not move or carry the dryer whilst it is running
