RISK ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

Potential Hazard(s)

Injury from contact with moving parts

Risk Level High

Control Measures Make sure all operators are competent in the use of the saw and that the saw is in

good working order and properly maintained.

Familiarise all users with safe use practice and emergency stop procedures and

always keep first aid supplies on hand.

Remain alert and aware of potential dangers/risks.

Never operate if fatigued, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Brick saws are designed for one person operation only.

Protective clothing/equipment including eye & ear protection and fully enclosed

footwear must be worn at all times during operation.

Do not remove protective guards. Ensure blade cover is fitted while not in use.

Keep all loose clothing, limbs, hair away from moving parts.

Maintain firm footage. Avoid working on uneven or slippery terrain.

Avoid overreaching.

Do not use saw above shoulder height.

Cut only on full power.

Injury from impact/projectile

Risk Level High

Control Measures Maintain a safe area around the saw and ensure all unauthorised persons remain

away from the saw whilst in use.

Wear adequate protective equipment to avoid injury from debris ejected from

material being cut.

Never use body parts to brace or prop material being cut.

Hearing Damage

Risk Level Medium/High

Control Measures Hearing protection with a rating of SLC80db 26-360Db must be worn. Note

warning label on unit.

Electrocution

Risk Level Medium/High

Control Measures Do not handle electrical plug or machine with wet hands

Use extension leads that are designed for outdoor use only

Do not use if water has been introduced into motor until inspected by suitably

qualified electrical contractor.

Do not use near water hazards or in inclement weather.

Do not allow the blade to come into contact with the power cable.

Exposure to ultraviolet radiation if working outdoors

Risk Level Medium

Control Measures Wear sunscreen, hat, long sleeves and long pants.

Burn hazard

Risk Level Medium/Low

Control Measures Wear protective clothing during operation. Avoid contact with hot components.

Never operate the engine with heat shields removed.

KEY OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Ensure saw is up on a firm, level surface.
- 2. Attach water supply and check flow.
- 3. Dry hands and connect power supply, ensuring lead is secured away from the cutting blade, and in a position where it will not become a trip hazard.
- 4. Turn saw on and allow to reach full speed before use.
