

5kVA Generator Operating Procedure

Please refer to Pre-Start Procedure prior to operating this equipment

Use **UNLEADED** fuel only.

1. To start unit:

- a) Turn the fuel lever to the ON position
- b) Ensure engine stop switch is in the ON position For cold starting use the choke lever
- c) Move throttle to low speed position
- d) Gently pull the starter grip until you feel resistance. Allow to gently recoil. Start the engine by swiftly pulling the recoil rope. Allow rope to gently recoil. Repeat if necessary.
- e) As the engine warms up, return the choke lever to the open position.
- 2. <u>To commence operation</u>, open the throttle to the full factory set speed. The unit is factory set to provide correct power supply. **Do not reduce** the throttle or adjust the speed setting as this will reduce the output required to power the appliance.

NOTES:

- **Do not overload** the unit by attempting to power an appliance beyond the output capabilities of the generator
- Use only heavy duty 15Amp extension leads
- Test the operation of the safety switch before connecting any appliance If the safety switch trips off, disconnect the faulty appliance and have it checked

3. **To stop unit:**

- a) Return the throttle to low speed, turn the stop switch to OFF
- b) Turn fuel lever to OFF position

When welding, the frame of the unit must not be in contact with the material being welded, or damage to the wiring will result.
